#### **General information**

Remove contaminated, saturated clothing immediately. Provide fresh air. Put victim at rest, cover with a blanket and keep warm. In case of accident or unwellness, seek medical advice immediately (show directions for use or safety data sheet if possible).

#### After inhalation

Provide fresh air. Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is irregular or stopped, administer artificial respiration. Where appropriate artificial ventilation. Call a physician immediately.
